You will need to submit the following items to your Google Drive Scholarship folder. \*\*Instructions for submitting your files are on the next page.

1. A **letter of application** that lists those scholarships you want to be considered for and specific reasons for each as to why you see yourself as a viable candidate. See attached example.
2. A **resume** providing the selection committee with valuable information regarding the past four years. See attached example.

Print, sign and turn in a copy of the **Release of Information** page to Student Services immediately following your electronic submission. This will be used to verify the receipt of your electronic submission.



2. Go to 'Shared With Me'




3. Find the folder with the name '*LastName, FirstInitial Scholarships*'

# LITTLE CHUTE HIGH SCHOOL 201 SCHOLARSHIPS/AWARDS

## SECTION ONE

### **THE FOLLOWING SCHOLARSHIPS REQUIRE A COMPLETED APPLICATION IF YOU WISH TO BE CONSIDERED AS A CANDIDATE**

1. **AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY TECHNICAL COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP** - A \$300 scholarship will be awarded to a female student accepted into an accredited vocational/technical college. Demonstrated good moral and social influence and "need" are factors.
2. **AMY DE BRUIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** - A \$600 scholarship will be awarded to a senior who has demonstrated outstanding effort and dedication to achieve. Grades are not a factor, effort is. Need is considered a priority. The scholarship must be used toward the cost of post-secondary education.
3. **AUDREY M. DRIESSEN NURSING SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$500 scholarship will be given annually to a senior who is entering a state recognized nursing program either RN or LPN.
  - a. *\*An essay stating your reason for pursuing a nursing degree must accompany the application.*
4. **BLC COMMUNITY BANK OUTSTANDING MATH STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP** - \$750 will be awarded to a senior who has demonstrated outstanding achievement in the math field during his/her high school career.
5. **BLC COMMUNITY BANK OUTSTANDING SENIOR STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP** - \$750 will be awarded to a senior student who has demonstrated outstanding qualities in the areas of scholarship, character, leadership, loyalty, and service.
6. **BRAD BORGEN/EDWARD JONES SCHOLARSHIP** – A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a senior attending an accredited post-secondary institution who has a minimum cumulative GPA of a 3.0. The recipient must have achieved to the best of their ability throughout their high school career. They need to have shown active involvement in high school activities or have held part-time employment throughout their high school career. Financial need is a strong consideration for the scholarship.
7. **BUILDING SERVICES GROUP ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP** - A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to the outstanding senior female athlete. The recipient must attend an accredited post-high school educational institution. The athlete must have earned a minimum of four letters in two or more sports and not have had a violation of the athletic code during her four years of high school.
8. **CARL HAMMEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS** - Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to two senior students, one male and one female, who have demonstrated sound academic and citizenship standards at Little Chute High School. Preference will be given to students with an involvement in an American Legion activity such as Badger Boy/Badger Girl, American Legion baseball, Boy Scouts, member of the military, relative of an American Legion member or past member, etc. Financial need is a definite consideration.
  - a. *\*A 100-500 word essay on "How have I demonstrated academic achievement and citizenship while at Little Chute High School, and how do I plan to continue both in the future?" must accompany your application.*

9. **CHEESE FEST SCHOLARSHIPS** - Four \$1000 scholarships are to be awarded to qualified students. Three scholarships will go to students attending a four-year college and one to a technical college. Applicants must have participated in some way as a volunteer or performed some service for Cheese Fest.  
*\*Needs an additional application which is available on the Little Chute School District website under the student services tab.*
10. **E-Z GLIDE ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP** - A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to the outstanding senior male athlete. The recipient must attend an accredited post-high school educational institution. The athlete must have earned a minimum of four letters in two or more sports and not have had a violation of the athletic code during his four years of high school.
11. **FUTURE BUSINESS LEADERS OF AMERICA SCHOLARSHIP** - A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a senior student who is pursuing a post-secondary degree in business or a business related field. The applicant must have maintained a 3.0 GPA in business courses, has been a participant in FBLA for at least two years and is a current member, and who has leadership qualities.
12. **GENEVIEVE AND SIMON HIETPAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$400 scholarship in which need is a factor. The candidate must be accepted and is planning to attend a Catholic college or university.  
*This scholarship is given in even years only.*
13. **JAYCEES "ABOVE AND BEYOND" SCHOLARSHIP** - A \$500 scholarship will be given to a senior who is attending either a four-year university or technical college. The recipient must have maintained a 3.0 G.P.A., have shown effort and dedication to academics, be of positive character to self and others, been involved in community service or co-curricular activities or held employment throughout their high school career. Financial need is also a strong consideration.
14. **JOEL MEHLBERG SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$250 scholarship will be awarded a senior who has given significant time to his/her community, school and church. The recipient is to be well rounded in their involvement in high school. Special consideration will be given to those who have had involvement in the arts- musical, visual, drama. GPA is not a critical factor. The student needs to be attending any postsecondary school.
15. **JOSEPH HIETPAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$500 scholarship will be given to a senior who displayed extraordinary character while maximizing their potential throughout their high school career. Recipient can be attending any type of post-secondary institution.
16. **KAUKAUNA UTILITIES SCHOLARSHIPS** – A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a student who is pursuing a postsecondary education in engineering or some other technically related field. The student may attend a traditional college or a technical college. A second \$500 scholarship is available for someone who is interested in attending the Electric Power Distribution program offered by a Wisconsin technical college.  
*\*Needs an additional application which is on the Little Chute School District website under the student services tab.*
17. **KEN'S SPORTS/STEVE VOSTERS "RACING FOR ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE" MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** - \$500 will be awarded to a senior attending a post-secondary institution. The student must have demonstrated academic excellence throughout his/her high school career.
18. **KERMIS DUTCH FESTIVAL SCHOLARSHIP** - A \$1000 scholarship will be given to a senior who resides in Little Chute and attends Little Chute High School. The student must plan to attend an accredited post- secondary institution. Student must also have volunteered for a Kermis Festival this year or in the past.  
**\*Applicants must also submit a 500 word essay stating why they believe both community involvement and heritage are important in today's society. Do not include any identifying information in the essay, as each essay will be assigned a number before being forwarded to the Kermis selection committee.**

19. **NESTLE PIZZA DIVISION ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS** - Two \$600 scholarships will be awarded to two seniors who will attend an accredited post-secondary institution. Strong emphasis is placed on academic performance within the classroom.
20. **LAVERNE VANDEN HEUVEL SCHOLARSHIP** - A \$500 scholarship will be given to a senior who has demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities and has held a club or class office. The recipient must be accepted to an accredited technical college or four-year college.
21. **LITTLE CHUTE EDUCATION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS** - Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to two seniors pursuing a career in an education field. The recipient must be accepted by an accredited college or university. The senior selected should exhibit the character traits necessary for an educational and professional career.
  - *With your application, please submit an essay of at least 500 words describing how your educational experience in Little Chute impacted your decision to pursue a career in education.*
22. **LITTLE CHUTE EDUCATIONAL ENRICHMENT SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$500 scholarship will be given to a senior who has been active in all aspects of their high school career while performing at their highest level. Any senior pursuing a post-secondary education is eligible.
23. **LITTLE CHUTE PERFORMING ARTS SCHOLARSHIP**- Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded annually to one male and one female student who have participated in the performing arts program. Applicants must submit a narrative describing their involvement in one of the following: Band, Choir, Destination Imagination, Drama Theatre, Forensics, and Musical Theatre. The recipient must be attending an accredited technical college or university.
  - a. *\*Needs an additional application which is available on the Little Chute School District website under the Student Services tab.*
  - b.
24. **MARGE NELSON PERSEVERANCE SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$500 annual scholarship will be given to a graduating senior who has shown character in overcoming some kind of adversity (medical, physical, academic, social, etc.) in his/her life. The recipient must be attending a postsecondary school. Please address the adversity in your letter of application.
25. **MARY N. JANSSEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a senior who has demonstrated leadership skills, has shown dedication to community service and achieved academic success. Preference will be given to those students who exhibit financial need and who have taken positive action towards the promotion of abstinence from alcohol and drug use for themselves and their peers.
  - \*Needs an additional application which is available on the Little Chute School District website under the Student Services tab.*
26. **MUSTANGS MENTORS SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$250 scholarship will be awarded to a senior who has been actively involved in the mentoring program. The recipient must not have had a code violation and must be attending a post-secondary institution.

- 27 **PARKSIDE CARE CENTER SCHOLARSHIPS** - Two \$250 scholarships will be given to students who have been accepted by a postsecondary institution with the intent of pursuing a career in the health field. Upon notification of winning the award, the students will be invited to tour the facility and meet with residents on a mutually agreed date.
- 28 **ROBERT J. & JANE D. KLOZOTSKY SCHOLARSHIP** – A \$750 scholarship will be awarded to a senior who is planning to attend a four-year college or university. Applicants must have participated in at least two different extracurricular activities during their high school career and must have earned a cumulative 3.0 GPA.  
*\*Needs an additional application which is available on the Little Chute School District website under the Student Services tab.*
- 29 **RUTH HIETPAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$250 scholarship will be awarded to a senior who will be pursuing a post-secondary education. The recipient must be entering a field of study related to working with children.  
*\*Applicants must submit a separate essay to the Hietpas family as to why they should be considered for this scholarship*
- 30 **VANLIESHOUT VISUAL ART SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a senior who will be attending a post-secondary institution in a visual art field of study. Applicants must participate in the senior art show and have an art portfolio to be presented.
- 31 **VAN ZEELAND MFG. INC. SCHOLARSHIP** – A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from the Little Chute Career Pathways Academy who is pursuing a postsecondary education at a technical college in a manufacturing or engineering field.
- 32 **WITTMANN INSURANCE & FINANCIAL SERVICES SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$500 scholarship will be given to a senior who has been actively involved in extra-curricular activities and who possesses a positive attitude. The recipient should have overcome some type of obstacle and must have a good driving record.
- 33 **LITTLE CHUTE DIAMOND CLUB SCHOLARSHIP** - A \$500 scholarship will be given to a graduating senior softball player, and a \$500 scholarship will be given to a graduating senior baseball player. Applicants must have been a softball/baseball player for at least three full seasons and have positive character as an athlete and student in and out of school.  
*\*Applicant must complete supplemental application to the Little Chute Diamond Club Board of Directors*
- 34 **CHERRYLAND'S BEST ENTRENEURIAL SCHOLARSHIP** - Entrepreneurial Spirit Scholarship is a \$750 scholarship awarded to a Little Chute High School Student who exhibits great entrepreneurial spirit. To us here at Cherryland, entrepreneurial spirit is the motivation to better yourself and/or others on your quest to achieve success. Qualifications include Little Chute High School senior intending to enroll in a two or four-year college, university or technical school. Student is in good academic standing with a GPA of 3.0 or higher and a student who has been involved with FBLA at least two of the four high school years.  
*\*Applicant must complete supplemental application to Cherryland's Best.*

## SECTION TWO

### **THE FOLLOWING AWARDS DO NOT REQUIRE AN APPLICATION**

#### **ALL SENIORS ARE ELIGIBLE.**

1. **AMERICAN LEGION AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING SENIOR BOY** - \$100 and a plaque will be awarded to a senior boy who has demonstrated qualities in the areas of loyalty, character, service, leadership, and scholarship.
2. **AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING SENIOR GIRL** - \$100 and a plaque will be awarded to a senior girl who has demonstrated outstanding qualities in the areas of loyalty, character, service, leadership, and scholarship.
3. **BILL FITZPATRICK, SR - JAYCEES 110% AWARD** - A \$500 award will be given to a senior who shows a willingness to get involved in all aspects of school activities and who has always given 110% to accomplish their goals.
4. **DICK VAN EPERN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$250 award given annually to a senior who has shown consistent effort throughout their high school career. The student has to have had an I.E.P. or a 504 plan and must be attending a post-secondary institution.
5. **LEE VERBRUGGEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**- A \$250 award given annually to a senior who has shown consistent effort throughout their high school career. The student has to have had an I.E.P. or a 504 plan and must be attending a post- secondary institution with the intent of entering the trades.
6. **IMAD (I Made A Difference) AWARD** –six \$250 awards, sponsored by LCHS Student Council, will be given to senior leaders planning to further their education. Leaders will be nominated by club advisors for an opportunity to receive an IMAD award.
7. **MIKE MOLLEN HUMANITARIAN AWARD**- \$100 awarded annually to a senior who has been kind and helpful to others, has a sound moral background and is concerned and helpful to the less fortunate. That person’s name will be engraved on the plaque that permanently hangs in the hallway of LCHS.
8. **MIKE MOLLEN OUTSTANDING MALE ATHLETE AWARD** - Awarded annually to a senior male athlete who has contributed the most to the success of varsity athletics during his career at Little Chute High School. His name will be engraved on a large permanent plaque. The athlete must not have had a violation of the athletic code in his four years of high school.
9. **MUSTANG SCHOOL SPIRIT AWARDS** – Up to eight \$200 awards will be given to students who have demonstrated a positive involvement throughout their high school career and who previously have received no other recognition or award for their accomplishments. Preference given to those involved in athletics.
10. **OUTSTANDING SENIOR FEMALE ATHLETE AWARD** - Given annually to the senior female athlete who has contributed the most to the success of varsity athletics during her career at Little Chute High School. Her name will be engraved on a large permanent plaque. The athlete must not have had a violation of the athletic code in her four years of high school.
11. **REYNEBEAU FLORAL INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC RECOGNITION AWARDS** - Three \$50 awards will be given to seniors who have demonstrated outstanding involvement and effort in the Little Chute High School instrumental music program.

12. **REYNEBEAU FLORAL VOCAL MUSIC RECOGNITION AWARDS** - Three \$50 awards will be given to seniors who have demonstrated outstanding involvement and effort in the Little Chute High School vocal music program. \*The amount in each area can vary, but a total of \$600.00 will be awarded.
