TWO REFERENDA QUESTIONS ON THE BALLOT

1. Technology Referendum Renewal—to exceed revenue limit for non-recurring purposes, by \$275,000 per year for five years for upgrades to technology including hardware, software and related infrastructure, and 1:1 computing for grades 5-12.
2. A building and improvement program at the Intermediate/Middle/High School to authorize the borrowing of \$17,770,000 over 20 years, to address:
 - Safety and security upgrades, infrastructure, and classroom renovation
 - Renovation of **S**cience, **T**echnology, **E**ngineering and **M**ath sections, parking lot redesign to alleviate drop off/pick up congestion and improve safety, office consolidation with a dedicated and secure entrance, renovation of kitchen/cafeteria/commons, physical education and multipurpose spaces, move growing Flex Academy from its rented location to the main campus
 - Replacement/relocation of 50 year old electric service; heating, ventilation and cooling upgrades
 - Modernization and consolidation of libraries

DID YOU KNOW?

- Computer science related jobs continue to grow much faster than average. By 2020, there is projected to be one million more computing jobs than skilled applicants to fill them. (Bureau of Labor Statistics)
- Little Chute Middle/High Schools maintain power with a 50 year old electric service. Replacement parts are no longer manufactured or in distribution.
- The Flex Academy, a District-run K-8 charter school, has an average of 25-50 students on the waiting list each year.

IF APPROVED, WHAT IS THE ESTIMATED COST TO DISTRICT RESIDENTS?

- **Question 1**, for a \$100,000 property, the approximate cost is **\$5** per year for five years. Approximate cost for a \$200,000 home is **\$10** per year for five years.
- **Question 2**, for a \$100,000 property, the estimated cost is **\$129** per year for the first two years, with a projected decrease in 2019-20 to **\$93**. For a \$200,000 property, the projected cost is **\$258** per year for the first two years, with a projected decrease in 2019-20 to **\$186**.
