


Survey Summary


- The community survey was conducted in late November/early December of 2016.


What is your age?




Do you live in the Little Chute Area School District?




Are you an employee of the Little Chute Area School District?



Do you have children attending our schools?




If you have school-aged children, what school(s) do they attend?




Overall, what impact do you feel the Little Chute Area School District is having on your home value?





Would you support renewing an operational referendum for \$275,000 to continue to execute the technology plan for each of the next five years?






What priority would you place on updating building infrastructure? (Residents Only)



What priority would you place on renovating space to create middle/high school science, technology engineering and math classrooms? (Residents Only)




What priority would you place on expanding the school's kitchen and renovating the cafeteria? (Residents Only)




What priority would you place on combining the schools' library media centers?












