

Important information about Medication

Dear Parent(s) and/or Guardian(s) of Little Chute Elementary School Students,

Please make arrangements to have any medication you have provided to our school for your child picked up by an adult prior to the end of the school year. If you think your child may need the medication still through the end of the year, please wait to pick it up until the last day of school or after the school year is completed. Medication cannot be sent home with your child and will need to be picked up by an adult. If medications aren't picked up by June 2, 2017 at 3:15PM, your child's medication will be transported to the district office and can be picked up there between the hours of 8AM-2PM Monday-Thursday until June 16, 2017. After this date, the medication will be disposed of according to district policy.

A friendly reminder, all medications that will be provided to the school for your child for the 2017-2018 school year will need a new medication order for that year. Please have the medication form, which can be found on the school's website under registration forms, filled out completely. This includes a physician signature for prescription medication.
