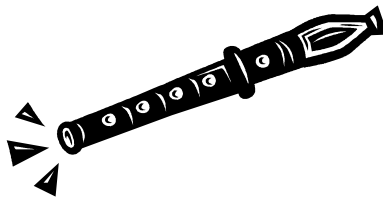
Dear 4<sup>th</sup> grade Parents/Guardians:

This year your student will be learning how to play the recorder in music class. A recorder is a musical instrument made out of plastic that you blow into and cover finger holes in order to produce different pitches.

We will be beginning this unit in October. Therefore, all students will need to bring money to purchase a recorder by October 7<sup>th</sup>. I have purchased enough recorders for all students to buy one. The cost is \$6.00. Please put the money in an envelope with your child's name on the outside and bring it to your homeroom teacher. Please use exact change if possible. Cash only please. Recorders will be kept in music class for most of the unit and then sent home with the student to keep after we are finished. If an older sibling has purchased the **same recorder** and has used it in music class, feel free to send it along instead of purchasing a new one. If you are unsure if it is the same one, please send it along to school so I can check it out.

If money is a problem please contact me at school or send a note with your student. I do have a few recorders in my classroom that students could borrow if needed.
