

Kindergarten Library Media Skills

Required Course

Course Description

During LMC classes throughout the school year, Kindergarten students learn how to select and locate materials in the library and how to choose materials of personal interest. They learn how libraries function and how to care for books. They identify elements of a story. Students come to LMC classes once every 4 days for one-half hour.

Unit: Accessing Information

Duration: Ongoing

Unit Overview

Students will describe the kinds of materials they find in a library and how library checkout works. They will recognize that books are arranged in a specific order and they need to return books to their designated spot after browsing.

Topic: Respect For Resources

Duration: Ongoing

Topic Overview

Students will use library resources in a responsible manner.

Learning Targets

Demonstrates proper book care; returns books on time
Description: Uses proper care when handling book in the library
Returns books to the LMC in good condition
Returns books on time & responds to overdue book notices

Uses a shelf stick correctly during checkout time.

Description: Asks for assistance from the librarian or aide if needed.

Topic: Information Seeking Strategies

Duration: Ongoing

Topic Overview

Students will search library resources for books of personal interest.

Learning Targets

Demonstrates an ability to locate some favorite books with assistance

Description: Begins to know which shelves in the LMC have books written by their favorite authors

Browses shelves for books of personal interest

Unit: Selection of Materials

Duration: Ongoing

Unit Overview

Students will begin to identify types of literature. They will examine methods and tools that will assist them in making choices for leisure

reading. They will develop an awareness of several authors' works.

Topic: Types of Literature

Duration: Ongoing

Topic Overview

Students will begin to distinguish between types of literature and develop an appreciation for literature.

Learning Targets

Can identify real versus make-believe and information vs stories

Description: Can identify "story" or "information" book

Identifies and locates parts of a book: cover, spine, spine label for holidays

Shows an active interest in listening to stories

Description: Listens attentively to stories

Relates story events to personal experience

Relates prior knowledge to story events

Topic: Book Selection Tools

Duration: Ongoing

Topic Overview

Students will be able to identify different kinds of literary needs, including personal interest and information. They will use selection tools of spine labels, cover and illustrations, and author preferences to aide in selection.

Description: Has a beginning awareness of a variety of authors and their works

Chooses books in a timely manner by looking at the cover and pictures

Uses the ABC sticker to locate easy reader materials

Students will begin to identify basic story elements of problem, pattern, humor, setting and other literary devices.

Begins to look for elements in independent reading

Identifies similarities & differences in different versions of a story

Recognizes stories based upon a song
