# First Grade Library Media Skills

Informational Media & Technology Literacy

Grade(s) 1st Required Course

#### **Course Description**

During LMC classes throughout the school year, first grade students learn how to select and locate materials in the library, choose materials of personal interest and locate favorite authors' books independently. They study several authors' books for style of writing and illustrating. Students come to LMC class once every four days for one half hour.

Unit: Accessing Information Course Details

**Duration:** Ongoing

#### **Unit Overview**

Students will develop skills for locating books in the fiction section of the LMC. They will recognize that books are arranged in a specific order and they need to return books to their designated spot after browsing. They will identify the location of the ABCs on the shelves and match the author's last name to the correct letter on the shelf. They will be able to distinguish between the kind of books found in the Fiction section and those that are Non-Fiction.

Topic: Respect For Resources

#### **Topic Overview**

Students will use library resources in a responsible manner.

### **Learning Targets**

- · Finds materials independently if he/she is able.

Description: Knows that fiction books are arranged by the author's last name Identifies the location of the ABCs on the shelves in the LMC
